

ANNOUNCEMENT TO FILL IN AVAILABLE POSITIONS AFTER THE FIRST YEAR OF THE DEGREE IN DENTAL HYGIENE A.A. 2024-2025

AVAILABLE POSITIONS

Following the regulation of the Dental Hygiene course, the following positions for the 2024-2025 academic year have become available:

- 2nd year: 9 positions for EU students
- 2nd year: 7 positions for extra EU students

The applications for positions after the first year can be submitted as herein specified.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Candidates need to register within the university system at the following webpage <https://unipr.esse3.cineca.it/Root.do> in order to create their own credentials. Further instructions are available at <https://www.unipr.it/registrazione>.

Afterwards, when entering in the reserved area within the section “Registrar’s Office” – “Evaluation test”- “Dental Hygiene- Valutazione domande di trasferimento da altro Ateneo/iscrizione ad anni successivi al primo”, the candidate should upload the documentation specified in the document “Come fare domanda”/“How to make an application”, which is needed for the application to be evaluated. The application must be sent between **23rd July and 9th August 2024**.

Applications sent after the established terms and applications sent according to different modalities **will not** be considered, as per D.D. 1925 del 30/11/2022 (*allegato 2, comma 9*): “Universities are not deemed to assess applications received in the absence of public announcements or through modalities other than the ones specified in the aforementioned announcements or outside the peremptory deadlines specified in the same”

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR APPLICATION

Applications can be sent by students already enrolled in Dental Hygiene courses for the A.A. 2023-2024 delivered in English and/or Italian.

In order to ensure adequate education standards, applications to be enrolled in years after the first from Degrees antecedent D.M. 270/2004 will not be accepted.

Students with curricula completed in foreign Universities must attach to the transferring application the original transcripts and the detailed programs of the courses attended, as well as the exams passed, together with a certified translation in Italian, issued from the competent authorities.

In case of students with a history of multiple transfers, certifications from the University that was effectively attended will be directly assessed; the Council for the Degree Course (CCL) will not take into account what was decided from other Universities following previous transfers.

Mandatory requirements to apply for registration at years after the first:

- a) For students enrolled in a Dental Hygiene course, it is mandatory to have passed the traineeship exam of the specific professional profile of the dental hygienist delivered in English related to the previous academic year or, as an alternative, if the traineeship exam was not registered yet at the time of the transfer/registration to years after the first, it is requested to attach a declaration from the Director of Professionalizing Activities (DADP) certifying that it was regularly performed with positive outcome
- b) For students registered in the Dental Hygiene degree delivered in Italian, it is mandatory to have passed the traineeship exam of the specific professional profile of the dental hygienist related to the previous academic year or, as an alternative, if the traineeship exam was not registered yet at the time of the transfer/registration to years after the first, it is requested to attach a declaration from the Director of Professionalizing Activities (DADP) certifying that it was regularly performed with positive outcome
- c) For students registered in the Dental Hygiene degree delivered in Italian, it is necessary to provide at least a B2 certification of English language

APPLICATION ASSESSMENT

The assessment of the applications will be done by the Didactic Commission and ratified in the first possible Council of the Course.

The commission will assess the applications mainly in relation to the following criteria:

- Adequacy of the didactic programme of the exams passed in the former University;
- Number of University credits (CFU) or equivalents (ECTS or based on the Country of origin);
- Number and marks of the passed exams;
- Based on the exams performed by the student in the former University, verification of all propaedeutic activities and block exams established within the regulations of the Dental Hygiene Course at University of Parma.

In case the number of potentially suitable applications is higher than the available positions, a ranking list will be drawn based on the following:

For transfers from the same degree delivered in English from Italian universities: total number of passed exams and higher weighted mean at the time of application (in case of further equality, the youngest)

For transfers from foreign Universities* (EU or extra-EU), higher number of ECTS (in case of further equality, the youngest)

*Foreign Universities must be accredited from the competent authority of the specific Country for a degree with the same denomination.

In case the student transfers from other Universities, whenever doubts persist in relation to the recognition of credits related to former didactic activities or whenever it is deemed necessary to verify that they are not obsolete, the CCL can request a formal verification, even interdisciplinary, to determine the number of credits to recognize.

CFU obtained from another Degree from the same University or from other Universities or other educational paths (professional training courses, professional activities, etc.) may be recognized after the positive opinion of the professor responsible for that module or teaching activity, once they have checked the documentation, learning objectives and content of the didactic modules for which the recognition is requested. The recognition could be in the form of the whole exam, part of the exam, attendance, part of the attendance, or the professor may request supplementations/integrations for the recognition of the exam.

Incomplete applications and applications performed according to different modalities or beyond the terms specified in the current announcement will not be assessed.
