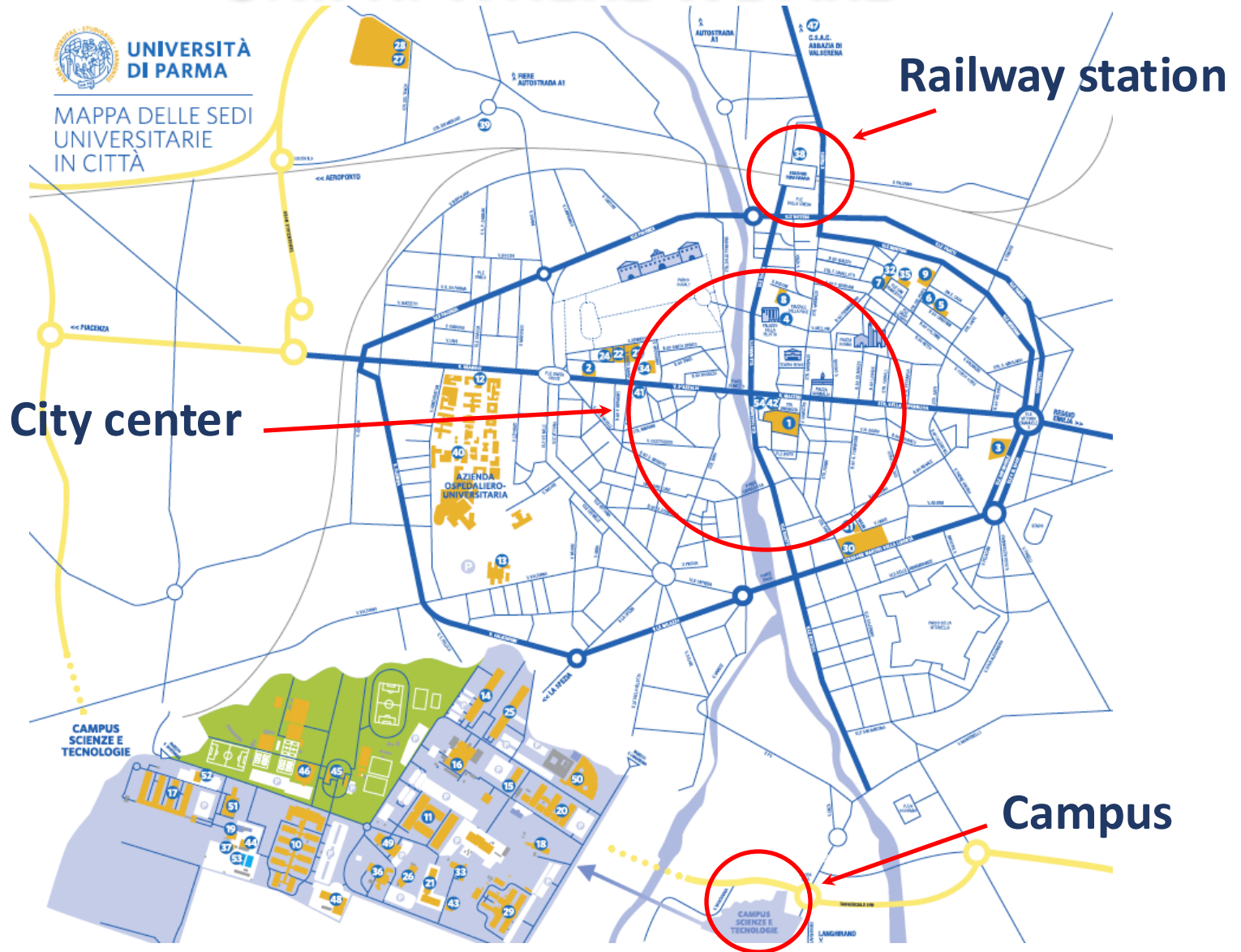

The Student Card is the multi-service card, created in collaboration with Crédit Agricole Italia, dedicated to students in the University of Parma.



The Student Card allows you to:

-  Access the University's **services** (libraries and others)
-  Benefit from **discounts** at participating establishments
-  Benefit from the **economic advantages** reserved to university students by external bodies and organisations (e.g. public transport, museums, cinemas).

In addition, if activated as a prepaid card, you can:

-  Receive **reimbursements** and **payments from the University**
-  Pay for **canteen** services, also in **contactless** mode
-  Purchase **TEP tickets** by downloading the Tep SmartTicket App
-  Carry out main **banking operations, including:** paying **university fees, rent** and **utilities**, making phone top-ups and **purchases**, also **online**

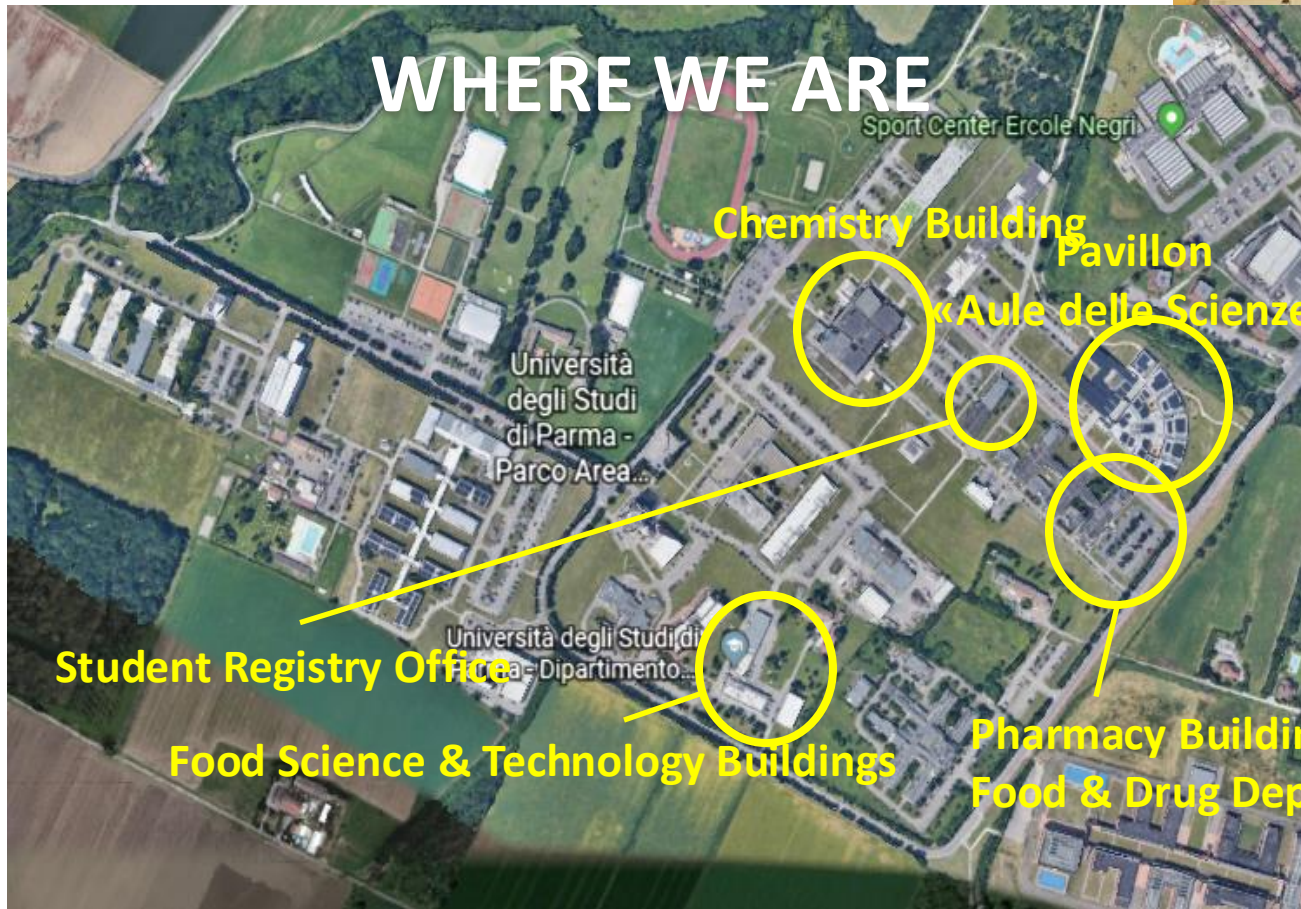

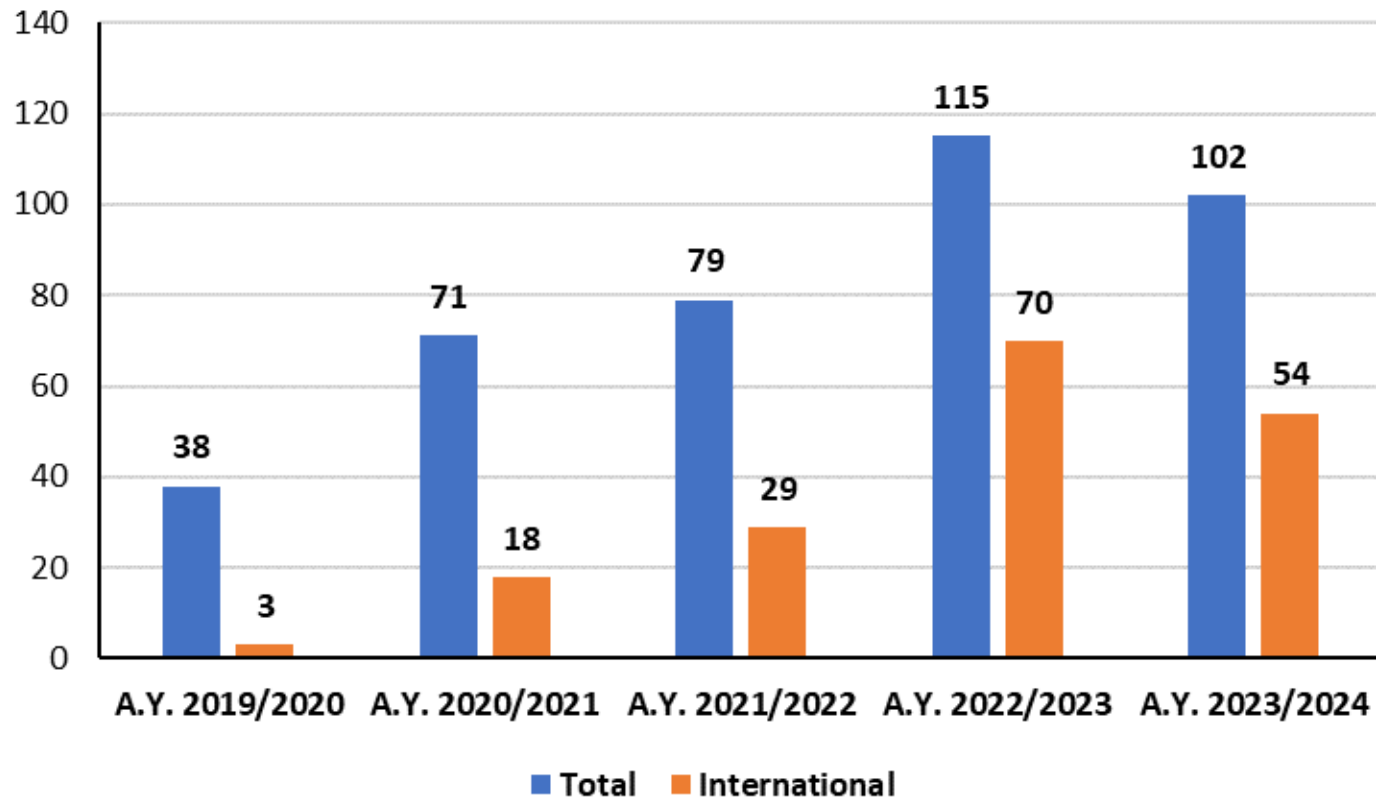
